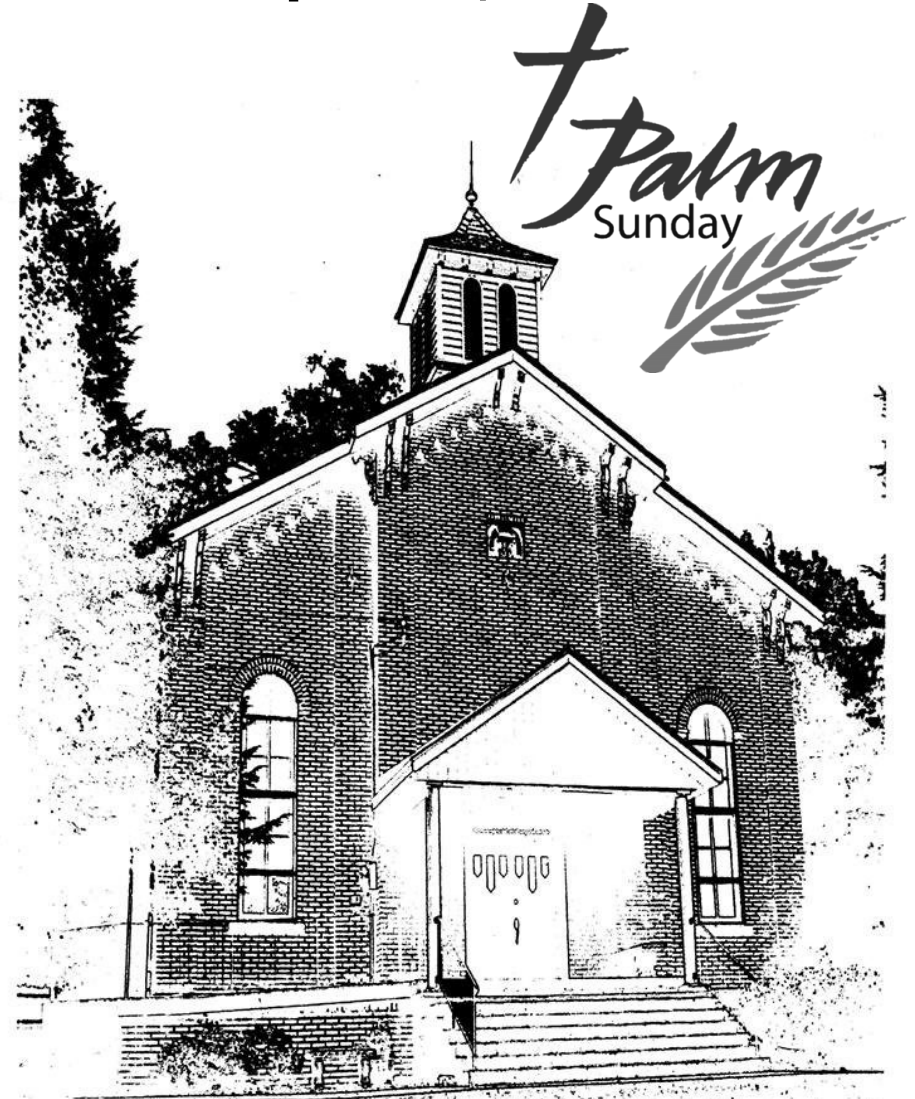
Thank you to everyone who participated in our Easter Pie Fundraiser! The Church was able to bring in \$110.00 from sales and donations received from this fundraiser.
