

Apostles' Creed

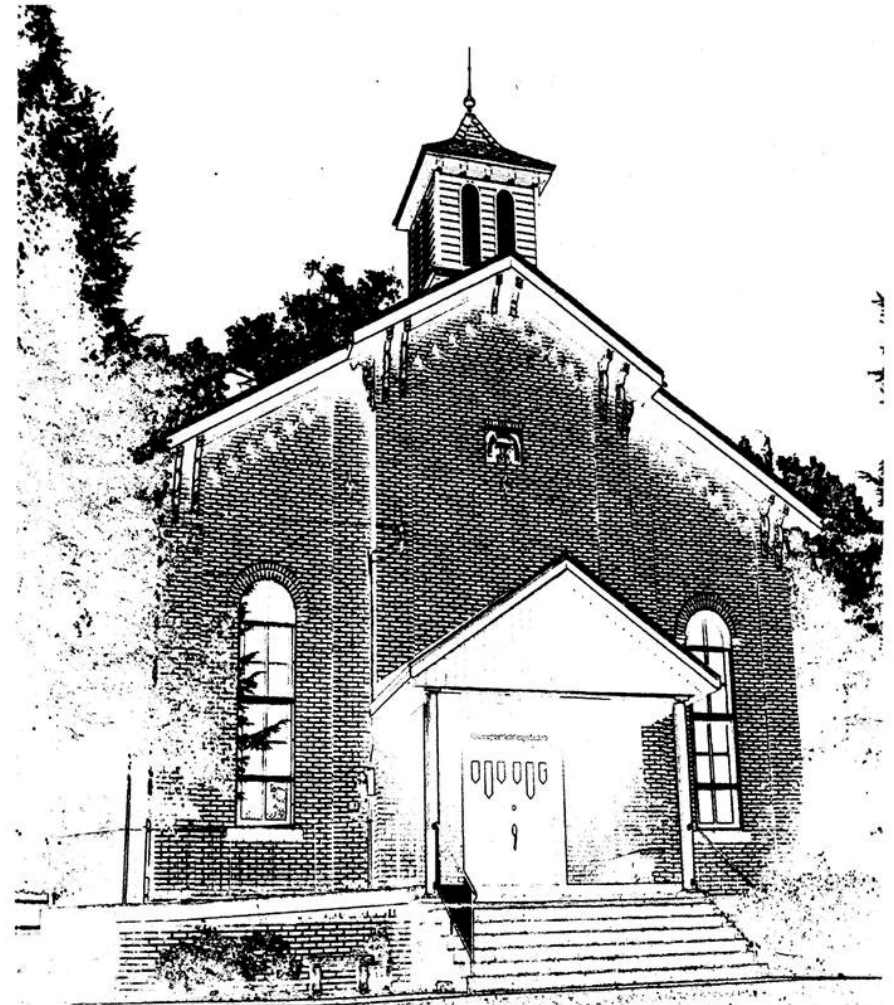
I believe in God the Father Almighty,

An the life everlasting.

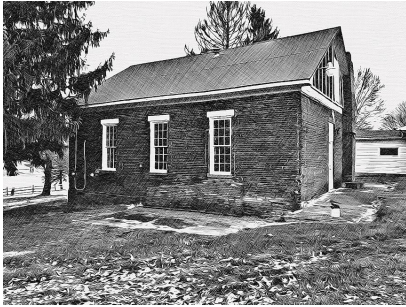
